

### A-Level

A-Levels are the traditional route to university study in the UK, and remain a gold-standard qualification recognised around the world.

A-Levels are usually studied over two years, with the final grade based on exams taken at the end of the second year at a recognised exam centre.

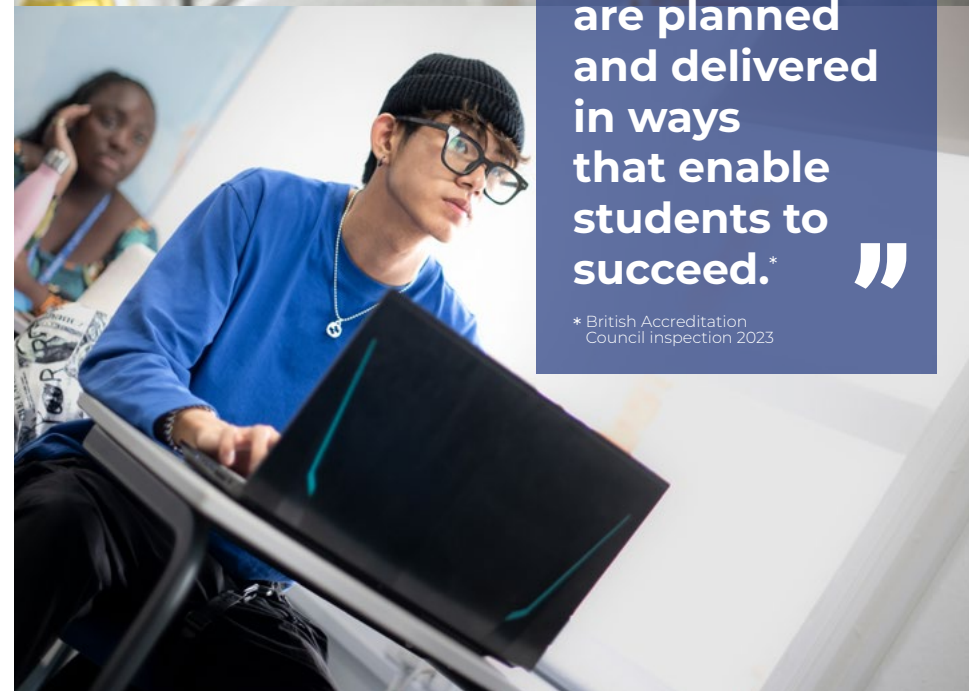
Students usually study 3 A-Levels, linked to the university degree to which they aspire. A student wishing to progress to medical school might study biology, chemistry and maths while a student wishing to study Computer Games Design might study art, linguistics and computer science. The same A-Level subjects can lead to many different degree programmes, offering students flexibility as their areas of interest may change and expand throughout the course.

## Foundation

The Foundation Programme is the fastest way for international students to enter a UK university.

Available over either 6 or 9 months, the Foundation Programme course is tailored to suit your interests and the degree course for which you intend to apply. Most students study three core academic subjects which give them the best chance of getting into university. A student taking a Foundation in Engineering might study maths, mechanics and physics, whereas a student studying a Foundation in Business Management might study psychology, business studies and economics.

On the 9-month programme, students can also take the Extended Project Qualification. This guided self-study programme enhances your independence, critical thinking and study skills. It is highly valued by universities and worth additional UCAS points, boosting your chances of accessing the top universities.

### Why study Foundation with us?

- ▶ Our Foundation programmes are proudly independent.

This means that you are able to choose to apply to any of the 100+ UK universities that accept our programme, rather than being restricted to 2 or 3 'partners'.

- ▶ We provide support course that help you with study and research skills.

## Master's Preparation

Our Master's Preparation Programme caters to students who have secured offers to pursue postgraduate degrees at UK or English-speaking universities.

Whether you are coming straight from an undergraduate degree or you have been out of study for a while, we want you to feel confident about studying for a master's in the English language. Tailored to each learner's specific postgraduate program, our online course equips students with core skills and competencies essential for seamless integration into the UK academic landscape.

### How do we help students prepare for postgraduate study?

#### ▶ Academic English

Aiming at boosting students' English language proficiency. The extent to which students focus on reaching the English proficiency necessary for postgraduate studies depends on their starting level upon enrollment.

#### ▶ Research Methods and Skills

Focusing on developing students' key skills required for them to undertake independent study and research.

#### ▶ Subject Knowledge Enhancement

Our experienced and knowledgeable tutors prepare students for the transition between undergraduate to postgraduate learning in their chosen field of study.

## Pre-PhD

Our Pre-Doctoral Programme caters to international students who have attained master's level education and aspire to pursue MPhil and/or doctoral studies in English.

This fully online program spans three months, commencing in September or January. Our primary goal is to assist students in honing essential doctoral study skills, including information and data analysis, literature reviews, and research methods. Additionally, we provide guidance in designing, writing, and presenting research proposals to enhance students' prospects of acceptance into a UK university doctoral program.

Prospective students should have completed studies at least at Level 6 or equivalent, and obtained an IELTS score of at least 6.5 or equivalent overall. Our programs feature an Academic English module aimed at strengthening students' English language proficiency to a level conducive for pursuing a PhD, DBA, or MPhil with confidence.



## Support Courses

Our support courses - included in every Academic programme - ensure that students are fully prepared for the next step and ready to thrive and succeed at university.

### Academic English

The vast majority of our international students require development of their English both to study effectively and to achieve the necessary IELTS score for university entry. Alongside our academic classes, all students also study 10 hours of Academic English per week.

These cross-curricula classes are interactive and dynamic, allowing students from different subjects to meet, interact and get to know each other. As well as improving language, this course also helps to build the sense of family and community within the college.

### TRACES

TRACES aims to find and develop the very best of the student, which focuses on critical thinking, research ability, and teamwork and leadership skills. We then encourage students to apply these logical strategies to a range of subject areas, including science, law and moral theories.

### UCAS Workshops

The UCAS workshops ensure that university applications are completed comprehensively and ahead of time, giving the best chance of progression, and removing any last-minute stress. All students attend a series of workshops during their course, where our specialist tutor takes them through the university application process step-by-step.

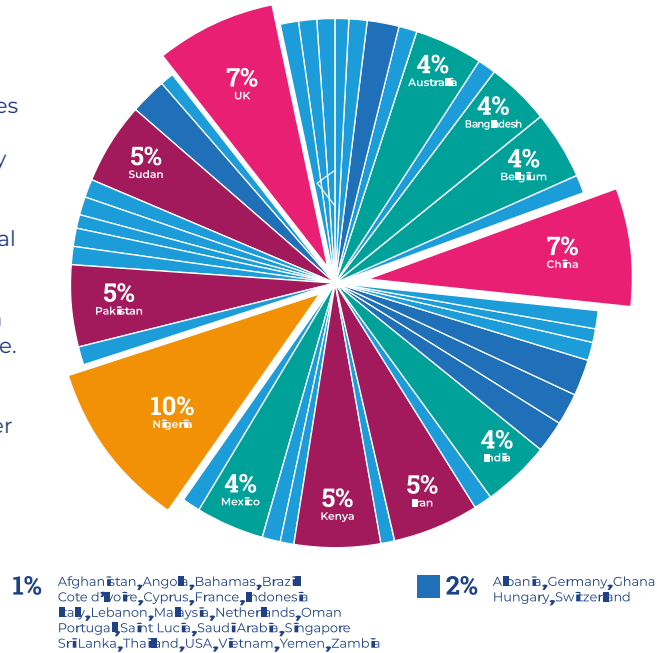

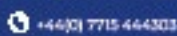
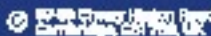
